6. was (Collective noun acting as a single unit)
7. need ('Several' is plural)

8. *is* (Subject names ending in -es take a singular verb)
9. *lives* ('One' is the true singular subject)
10. *is* (A single specific quantity/distance)
11. *was* (Words linked by 'along with' do not change the singular subject)
12. *have* ('Both...and' creates a plural subject)
