

Common noun - A general name for any person, place, animal, or thing.

The Secret: It does not start with a capital letter (unless it is at the start of a sentence).

Examples: boy, city, dog, pencil, school.

Proper noun - A special, specific name given to a person, place, animal, or thing.

The Secret: It always starts with a Capital Letter!

Examples: Sam, London, Max, Sunday, Christmas.
