1. PAST TENSE EXAMPLES

- * Simple Past: Sameer lived in a small village.
- * Past Continuous: He was dreaming... (implied state) / used to study.
- * Past Perfect: He had completed his schooling.
- * Past Perfect Continuous: He had been dreaming of becoming a scientist for many years.

2. PRESENT TENSE EXAMPLES

- * Simple Present: Sameer works in a big research centre.
- * Present Continuous: He is researching a new medicine.
- * Present Perfect: He has completed many important experiments.
- * Present Perfect Continuous: He has been working on this project for the last five years.

3. FUTURE TENSE EXAMPLES

- * Simple Future: Sameer will go to America next month.
- * Future Continuous: He will be presenting his research.
- * Future Perfect: He will have completed the discovery of this medicine.
- * Future Perfect Continuous: He will have been working for the welfare of humanity.
