GRAMMAR BREAKDOWN (PAST TENSE TYPES)**1. Simple Past Tense**

** Structure: Subject + V2 + Object*

** Ravi lived in his village.*

** He became worried.*

** Ravi immediately handed over the bag.*

2. Past Continuous Tense

** Structure: Subject + was/were + V1 + ing + Object*

** He was going to the city.*

** The man was panting heavily.*

** He was just looking for that person.*

3. Past Perfect Tense

** Structure: Subject + had + V3 + Object*

** The bus had left.*

** Someone had left a black bag there.*

** Someone had forgotten their valuable belongings.*

4. Past Perfect Continuous Tense

** Structure: Subject + had been + V1 + ing + Object + since/for + Time*

** He had been preparing for this exam since morning.*

** He had been searching for his bag since morning.*
