3. A shopkeeper has 153 candles. He buys 237 more candles from another shop. How many candles does he have in total?
4. In a school, there are 456 students in Class 1 and 289 students in Class 2.
 - a) What is the total number of students in both classes?
 - b) How many more students are there in Class 1 than in Class 2?
5. Meena has ₹350. She wants to buy a toy that costs ₹500. How much more money does she need?
6. Estimate the lengths of the following objects and then measure them to find the difference between your estimate and the actual length:
 - a) A pen
 - b) A pencil box
 - c) Your mathematics textbook
7. Reena's mother tells her to walk 50 steps from the front door to the garden. If each of her steps is 40 cm long, what is the total distance she walks in meters?
